





Step – by – Step Instructions

Step # 1 - Choose the right brake pads




Step # 2 - Push the piston back from the caliper








Step # 3- Determine if rotors need to be replaced




Step # 4 - Wash and dry the rotors








Step # 5 - Clean and lubricate caliper sliding surfaces




Step # 6 - Clean the hub and ABS components







Step #7 - Replace brake hardware




Step #8-Check brake fluid levels and color
