

Application Instructions

- 1. Clean glass with an ammonia-free cleaner, like Dr. Beasley's Glass Cleanser.
- 2. Use Glass Coating Prep to remove any stubborn contaminants remaining.
- **3.** Wrap the suede cloth around the foam applicator and place several drops of Glass Serum down the cloth.

4. Slowly and precisely move the suede-wrapped foam block applicator in overlapping vertical lines down the glass.

- 5. Repeat with horizontal lines, creating a crosshatch pattern to get maximum coverage.
- **6.** Allow Glass Serum to dwell on the glass for ~ 10 minutes.
- 7. Wipe the glass with a clean, dry, glass towel.

Dr. Beasley's Suggests:

Allow Glass Serum to cure for 1 hour before driving. Do not wash car for 7 days after applying Glass Serum. Use only on exterior glass surfaces.

After Care Guide

Proper maintenance must be practiced to ensure Glass Serum lasts the full duration of its lifespan. This maintenance entails regular washes, occasional application of a maintenance booster product, and as-needed spot cleaning.

Regular Washes

To ensure Glass Serum continues to repel liquids and maintain clarity, contaminants must be removed frequently so they cannot layer on top. In order to prevent this build-up, we recommend washing the vehicle once every two weeks (or as needed)g usin Dr. Beasley's Ceramic Body Wash. When washing, make sure to follow these guidelines:

- Do not wash for the first seven days after applying Glass Serum.
- Only wash using the two-bucket method or a foam gun. Do not use an automated car wash.
- Use a Grit Guard in the rinse bucket to ensure contaminants are not reintroduced when rinsing.
- Wash out of direct sunlight to avoid streaking or water spots.
- Always use clean wash mitts to avoid dragging contaminants across the coating.
- Wash from top to bottom to ensure contaminants are fully removed.
- Only use microfiber glass towels when drying your glass to avoid abrading the coating.

Maintenance Boosters

Beyond washing, semi-frequent use of a maintenance booster product is also necessary to ensure Glass Serum continues to perform at a high level. We recommend adding our maintenance booster AdvanceCoat: Glass to your wiper fluid reservoir whenever adding new wiper fluid. This product contains the chemical components that make up Glass Serum concentrated into a shot so the coating can be bolstered without the need for re-application. When adding AdvanceCoat: Glass to your wiper fluid reservoir, be sure to follow these guidelines:

• Be sure wiper fluid reservoir contains 1 gallon of wiper fluid before adding the AdvanceCoat: Glass shot.

Occasional Spot Cleaning

It is necessary to clean any contaminants that appear in-between washes as soon as reasonably possible to keep Glass Serum in optimal condition. This is especially the case for acidic contaminants such as bird droppings or insect remains. To remove these contaminants, we recommend using Dr. Beasley's Glass Cleanser. This cleanser works by breaking down the contaminant chemically, allowing it to be wiped away with a microfiber towel. When using Glass Cleanser, be sure to follow these guidelines:

- Shake well before use.
- After observing a new contaminant, clean with Glass Cleanser as soon as reasonably possible.
- Only use a clean, microfiber glass towel to wipe away the contaminant.
- Be sure to flip the towel over before hand buffing.
