



### Switch Panel installation Instructions

1. Pick out the name plates you would like to use and attach them to the switches. The name plates have a small notch that will align on the switch in order to stay in the correct location at all times.

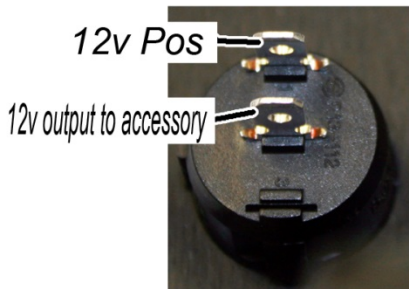


2. Push the name plate firmly up on to the switch.
3. Once you have the name plates on the switches you can install the switches into the switch panel in any order you choose. The Switch panel also has a notch that the switch will slide into to keep the switch from turning.

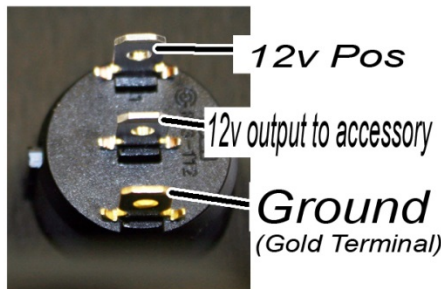


4. To wire the switches follow these diagrams:

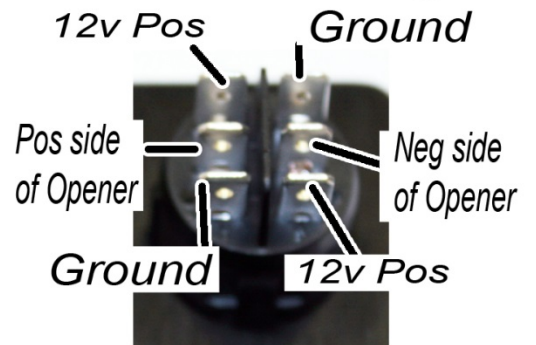
#### *Momentary Switch Wiring*

For the Chevrolet pickups/SUV's you will need to remove the dash bezel to install the switch panel.

1. Set the parking brake.
2. Move the column shift lever (on Automatic transmission vehicles) into D1.
3. Pull the dash bezel from the corner and the bezel should pop loose, it is best to remove the bezel completely for now.



4. Once the dash is removed unclip the small storage compartment, this will be replaced with the switch panel.



5. Place switch panel where the small compartment was.



6. Reinstall dash bezel.
