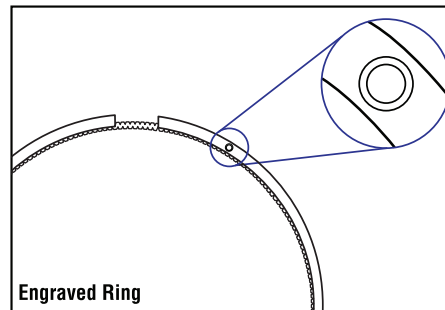
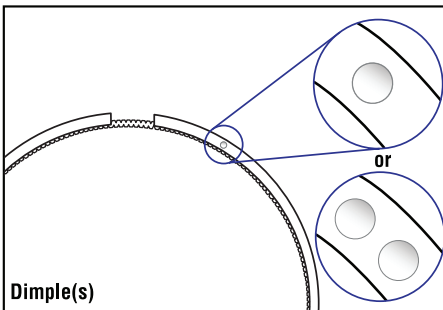
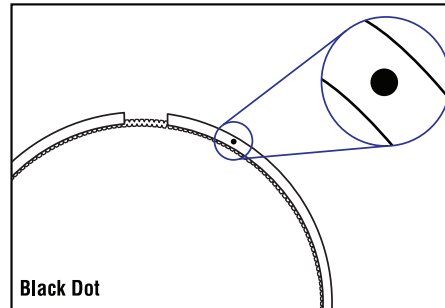
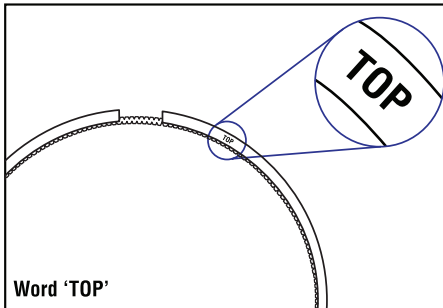


Compression rings, intermediate rings, and many oil control rings are directional, i.e. they require that a specific side faces toward the top of the piston.

The following are examples of the possible marks that could be present on one side of the ring designating the side that faces up.

- The word "Top"
- A black dot
- Single or double dimples
- An engraved ring



**NOTE: There may be other marks not listed here, which are present only on one side of the ring that indicate the side that faces up**
