



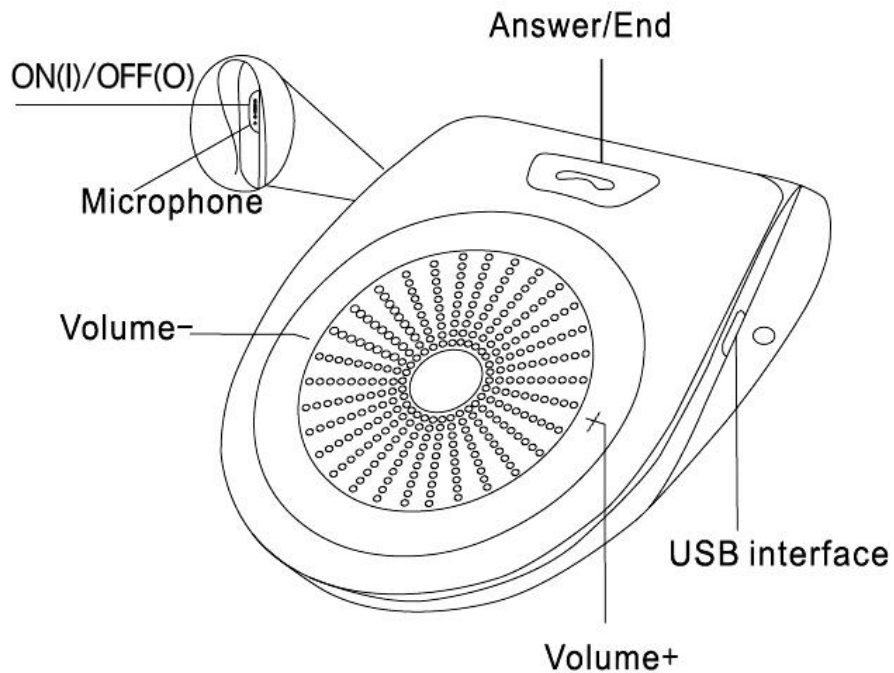
Sun Visor Bluetooth Handsfree Speakerphone

Operation Manual

(Model #: HFM-17C)

Overview

This portable Bluetooth In-Car Speakerphone is specially designed with the aims of convenience and freedom of wireless communication. This Speakerphone is powered by a micro-USB cable. Use with the included car cigarette lighter adapter to charge in the car, or use a wall adapter to use as a conference speakerphone at home or in the office. The advanced built-in microphone uses DSP technology for echo cancellation and noise reduction. This Bluetooth In-Car Speakerphone brings you an outstanding full duplex sound quality.

Operation

Installation

With the built-in clip, simply attach the Speakerphone to your sun visor.

Charging the Bluetooth In-Car Speakerphone

This device has a built-in rechargeable battery. We strongly recommend fully charging the battery before first use. Charging time is 3 hours.

Important note:

- (1) The LED power charging indicator will have a short delay after the Speakerphone is plugged in. The Speakerphone's battery will gradually lose charge over time if not plugged in.
- (2) In order to extend the life of the battery and ensure that the performance of the Speakerphone remains high, we recommend charging the Speakerphone as soon the low battery indicator comes on. When in a low battery state, the LED indicator will flash red every 2 seconds. The Speakerphone will also verbally announce "Battery Low". When the battery is critically low, the Speakerphone will automatically shut off.
- (3) While charging, the LED indicator will stay red, and will turn off when charging is complete.

ON/OFF

Slide the switch to "I" to power on. Speakerphone will announce "Power On". Slide to "O" to shut off.

Bluetooth smartphone pairing

To use the Bluetooth In-Car Speakerphone, please pair your Bluetooth-enabled smartphone to the Speakerphone. This device supports simultaneous dual phone pairing. Please follow the steps below to pair your smartphone. Repeat these steps to pair a second smartphone.

- (1) For best initial pairing results, place your smartphone and Speakerphone within 1 meter of each other.
- (2) When the LED indicator flashes blue, the Speakerphone is ready to pair. The speakerphone will announce "Pairing".

Note: The Bluetooth In-Car Speakerphone automatically begins in pairing mode when turned on.

(3) Enable your smartphone's Bluetooth function, and navigate to the pairing menu.

(4) Select "Sondpex17" from the list of available devices. For some smartphones, you may need to enter "0000" if prompted for a pairing password. The LED indicator will flash blue every 3 seconds after a successful pairing, and the Speakerphone will announce "Connected".

(5) Your Speakerphone is ready to use!

Note: If the Speakerphone attempts to and fails to pair for more than 2 minutes, please turn it off and on before trying to pair again.

Bluetooth pairing with a second smartphone

If you are connecting a second Bluetooth-enabled smartphone, please follow these steps:

(1) Disconnect the first phone you paired with Speakerphone, either by switching off its Bluetooth connection, or by turning the device off.

(2) Turn off the Speakerphone.

(3) Repeat steps in "Bluetooth Smartphone Pairing" for the second smartphone.

Bluetooth In-Car Speakerphone Operation

(1) Answer a call

When a call comes in, the Speakerphone will ring, and announce the phone number of the caller. Press the Answer key to answer the call.

(2) Ending a call

During a call, press the Answer key to hang up.

(3) Redial last number

Firmly and quickly press the answer key twice to redial the last number.

(4) Volume control

Press the "-" or "+" keys to adjust the volume levels on a call or on music playback.

(5) Music playback

In standby mode, press the Answer key to start playing music from the connected device. Press and hold the "+" key to go to the previous track. Press and hold the "-" key to jump to the next track.

Siri and Google Now

When the speakerphone is paired through Bluetooth with an iPhone or compatible Android phone, the Answer key can activate Siri or Google Now.

Hold the Answer key down until you hear "Voice Dial" & an audible tone from the speakerphone. Speak into the speakerphone, and your device should receive your command. The Answer key functions like

the home button on the iPhone, or the corresponding button that activates Google Now on an Android device.

Language

This device supports three languages. Simultaneously press the “+” and “-” to toggle between languages in the order of: English, French and Spanish.

Maintenance

- (1) Keep the device away from wet, humid, and high temperature environments.
- (2) Keep the device away from any corrosive liquids.
- (3) Keep the device away from any sharp object to avoid scratches or damage.
- (4) Do not disassemble the device.
- (5) Keep the device in a dry environment when not in use.

Safety

- (1) Please use the device in a manner consistent with local traffic laws and regulations.
- (2) Please concentrate on the road while driving and using the device.
- (3) Keep the device away from children.
- (4) Never use the device where electronic or wireless communication is prohibited.
