- This product contains strong magnets that may cause interference with pacemakers and other implanted medical devices when placed within a close proximity. Keep this product at least 6 inches from your chest if you have a pacemaker.

OPERATION

- To turn unit ON: click the power button
- To change mode: Press the power button gently until desired flash pattern is found.
- To turn OFF: Click the power button.

Light patterns (run time)	
Flashlight (10 hrs) Triple-blink (32 hrs) Single-blink (100 hrs)	Rotate (13 hrs) Alternate (5 hrs) Solid-on (5 hrs)

BATTERY REPLACEMENT:

- Insert coin into slot on back of unit and turn counter clockwise to loosen and remove the battery cover.
- 2. Install 3 AA batteries
 - Replace the batteries in the proper orientation shown on the battery holder.
 - For best performance, always replace all batteries at the same time.
 Do not mix old and new batteries or batteries of different types (alkaline, heavy duty, and rechargeable).
- Replace the battery cover and turn clockwise to tighten using a coin to ensure a tight seal.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- All batteries discharge over time. Replace batteries every 6 months.
- Use a slightly damp cloth with mild detergent to clean the outer surface as needed.
- Batteries should be removed from your unit if it will not be used for an extended period of time.
